



Teachers/Staff iPad User Agreement

1. Carbon County School District #2 Policies Apply to iPad Use:

Policy IHAJ-R Internet Use Agreement

2. Teachers are responsible for the care and upkeep of the iPad.
3. Teachers/staff are responsible for reporting a lost or stolen iPad immediately. If the lost/stolen iPad is not recovered, the teacher/staff will be responsible for purchasing a new one. The teacher/staff is also responsible for any lost or damaged iPad accessories.
4. Any need for repairs or reports of damage should go directly to the school media center.
5. Teachers may download personal content (apps, music, etc) to the iPad they are assigned, as long as the content meets CCSD #2 rules for appropriate and legal rules. Do not alter (ex: jailbreak) the iPads in any way. Only download iTunes apps.
6. Any content deemed inappropriate or illegal will be removed by the CCSD #2 tech Staff and costs incurred by a teacher for the content will not be recoverable. For example: a teacher downloads an iPad app and pays \$1.99 for the app. The tech department determines the app contains inappropriate content (sexually explicit, obscene, etc.) and removes it. The teacher will not be reimbursed for the app he/she purchased. See policy IHAJ
7. Use of camera and video apps on the iPad must be appropriate and legal.
8. Photos and videos taken during the school day must be educational in nature and purpose. Any content stored on the iPad (including photos or videos) must meet CCSD #2 policies of appropriate and legal.
9. The iPad may be scanned at any time by CCSD #2, administrators or tech staff to determine all content is appropriate and legal. All content on the iPad is subject to CCSD #2 policy and should never be considered private.
10. The teacher assigned iPad remains the property of Carbon County SD #2.
